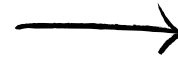
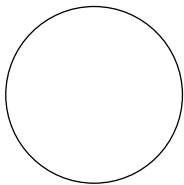
After cutting out the circles on the attached sheet, match each verse with the images on the circles based on the verse's content. Then, take a few days this month to focus on one verse at a time.

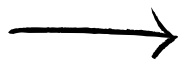
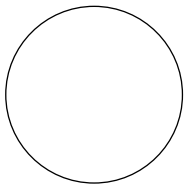
verse 15

Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation,



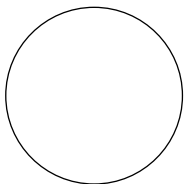
verse 16

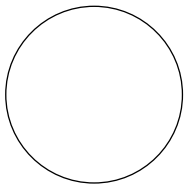
verse 17

He existed before anything else, and he holds all creation together.



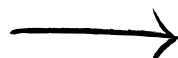
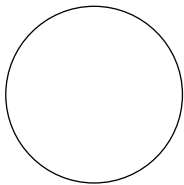
verse 18

verse 19

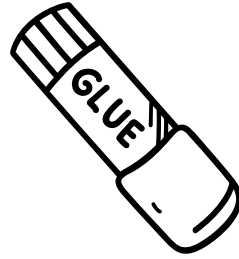
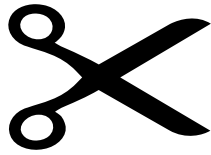
For God in all his fullness was pleased to live in Christ,
